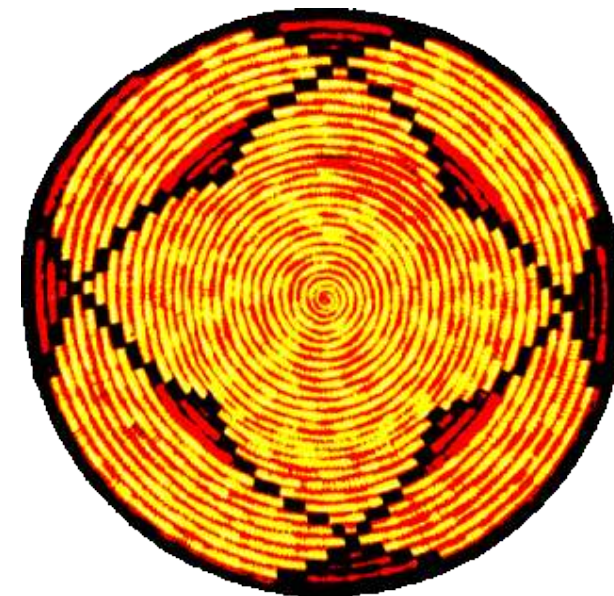

Humanitarian help

About 640 000 children under the age of 15 are newly infected with the HIV every year worldwide. Without treatment half of them will die before they reach their second birthday. 90% of these children live in sub-Saharan Africa.

About 16 million children under the age of 15 live in Uganda within a total population of 28 million. One million of these children have been orphaned due to HIV/AIDS.

**UAAH** supports several projects in the western region of Kabarole in the Southwest of Uganda. The main focus point lies in the rural areas around Fort Portal. We mainly provide financial support for education and medical treatment for AIDS orphans. Moreover UAAH aids several different self-help projects which aim to improve the living conditions of those infected and affected by HIV/AIDS.



## Education

Although primary school in Uganda is supposed to be free and available to everyone a lot of children still struggle to go to school – especially in the rural areas. Often the schools are too far away or simple things like clothing and school materials can not be paid for.

With only €15 a month we can dress a child, send it to school and provide the necessary medical treatment.



## AIDS Education

The *Ihunga Needy and Orphans Anti HIV/AIDS Group*, a youth group with about 45 members gives music, dance and theatre performances in the rural districts in order to educate their listeners about the threat of HIV/AIDS.

Through the help of **UAAH** donations trainings, costumes and transport costs to different villages in the surrounds are provided for the members of the group.

## Help to enable Self-Help

**UAAH** also supports several self-help projects in which women who have been either infected or affected by HIV/AIDS help and support each other through:

- common agriculture
- commercial use of grain mills
- provision of micro-credits for and between members of the group



## St. Theresa Vocational School

Only a few schools in the area provide secondary education including high school education. St. Theresa was founded in 2005 and apart from giving secondary education it also provides vocational trainings in several fields of workmanship – supported by **UAAH**.
